Taita Taveta Wildlife Conservancies Association (TTWCA) is an umbrella body of 33 conservancies covering about 1 million acres of land which form the greater Tsavo Landscape Conservation area in Taita Taveta County. The organization supports the conservancies in holistic and sustainable natural resource management to improve livelihoods through development of livestock enterprises, nature-based enterprises and general environmental conservation.

Key Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Provide logistical support to all conservancy in ensuring smooth running of the combating wildlife crime activities and other security operations.
2. Driving rangers to and from their patrols as assigned.
3. Ensuring proper maintenance of vehicles and tools assigned to them.
4. Ensuring safety of passengers/property in the vehicle.
5. Ensuring that valid road licenses are in place.
6. The driver should be competent at checking the vehicle for problems & performing pre/post journey maintenance tasks
7. Ensuring full compliance to the traffic laws, regulations and code.
8. Performing any other duties as may be assigned from time to time by the TTWCA management.
9. Proper recording of mileage booklet.
