OVERVIEW

TTWCA Background:

Taita Taveta Wildlife Conservancies Association (TTWCA) is a landscape community-based organization established in 2013 with the mandate to support the development of wildlife conservancies and other related economic activities among its members for improved livelihoods and coordinate sustainable management of the Tsavo ecosystem. TTWCA also serves as a landscape umbrella body for 35 conservancies/ranches covering approximately 1 million acres within the larger Tsavo landscape. The conservancies/ranches form a migratory corridor for the Tsavo National Park which is 5.8 million acres.

ZSL Background:

ZSL (Zoological Society of London), is an international conservation charity with the purpose to inspire, inform, and empower people to stop wild animals from going extinct. Their vision is a world where wildlife and people thrive.

ZSL's program in Kenya provides technical, logistical, and capacity-building support to KWS and other local partner NGOs, with a geographical focus on the Tsavo Conservation Area.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

TTWCA in partnership with ZSL with funding from the UK Government through the Darwin Initiative, will be implementing the project "**Equitable Responses to Illegal Wild Meat Hunting in Tsavo, Kenya.**" This project will work with and support frontier communities in the Tsavo Conservation Area (TCA) to improve livelihood prospects and well-being while protecting wildlife.

TTWCA is seeking the services of qualified and motivated individuals to carry out the social economic survey in the 3 Locations - Maktau, Mwachabo and Njukini.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct face-to-face interviews with selected participants in assigned areas.
- Collect accurate and reliable data on socio-economic factors (e.g. income, education etc.) using a smartphone-based survey tool.
- Ensure proper use of mobile data collection software and report any issues encountered.
- Maintain confidentiality and ensure that all information collected is handled ethically.
- Adhere to the project timelines and quality standards.

REQUIREMENTS:

- A smartphone (preferably Android) and the ability to use mobile apps for data collection.
- Post Secondary education
- Strong communication skills and the ability to interact with people from diverse backgrounds.
- Prior experience in data collection or survey work is preferred.
- Must be a resident of the three (3) Locations (Maktau, Mwachabo and Njukini)
- Reliable, punctual, and detail-oriented.
- Fluency in English, Kiswahili, Kamba and Taita is Mandatory.
